The purpose of the program is to promote debate on education system issues and student involvement in decision-making policies of public universities.



#### Case 1

\* In October 2017 we published the first Survey on the Perception on Corruption, from which the University of Elbasan came out as the most corrupted, with 77.5%.

\* In November 2017 - March 2018, we developed some communication sessions between the Anti-Corruption Office of the State Police and students in several Universities.
